Presented annually to one award recipient from each major party of the U.S. Congress for their service in furthering the application of science and technology toward ensuring a safe and abundant food supply for all, both domestically and internationally.

1. Current member of the U.S. Congress in good standing
2. Outstanding contributions to science-based, food-related policy such as sponsor or co-sponsor of legislation that contributes to a safe and abundant food supply
3. Distinguished lifetime service as a legislator with sustained attention to the scientific integrity of food-related policy and programs
4. Potential for long-term working relationship with IFT
5. Embodies IFT's spirit of inclusiveness and diversity as evidenced by their voting record and policy decisions
