**Contributions to the profession** of food science and technology in industry, academia, government, and related organizations: This may include: Research achievements, as evidenced by publications, patents and presentations; and Industry achievements, such as research management, innovative product and process development, inventions and patents, and Innovations in safety and quality systems.

**Honors, awards** and other evidence of recognition within the profession.

**Evidence of leadership** and achievements within the profession. For example: organization of or participation in conferences or industrial, academic, governmental, or international committees; training programs; mentoring professionals (especially new professionals), internal or external advisory activities and promoting participation in IFT activities.

**Service to IFT** including National, Regional, Divisional, and other IFT activities. If nominee resides outside of the USA, service to an IFT Affiliate is considered in lieu of or in addition to IFT service.

**Professional History** in reverse chronological order, beginning with the nominee's present position and including the 10 years that the nominee made key contributions to the profession and to IFT. Briefly indicate the responsibilities and the nature of the nominee's contributions in each position held, not just the title.
