Encourage the best young minds to pursue careers in the science of food

- Partnered with FONA International, NSTA, Chicagoland Food Science Foundation, and Nepris for strategic programming
- Awarded \$2,500 by Nepris as part of its “You Give We Give” campaign
- Exhibited at the virtual USA SciFest event (September 26–October 31, 2020), which attracted 75,400 attendees (students, educators, and parents)

- Awarded the inaugural Dr. Elwood F. Caldwell Graduate Fellowship
- Partnered with IFT sections, divisions, and sponsors to support more than 800 students annual event registration scholarships
