

Letter from the Chair

Dear Friends:

This past year Feeding Tomorrow entered an exciting new chapter, and I'm pleased to have this opportunity to share the news with you! In September the foundation joined IFT as a single 501c3 organization and came under the governance and fiduciary responsibility of the IFT Board of Directors. If you haven't already, you'll start to see our new name in circulation: the Feeding Tomorrow Fund. This transition is truly a win-win. It increases efficiencies, simplifies oversight, and offers more focus on programs of impact. It provides enhanced visibility for the fund while offering greater opportunity for IFT members to get involved, and it reduces administrative costs so that donor dollars can be maximized in support of our mission.

Speaking of mission—that has not wavered a bit. During 2021-22, the Feeding Tomorrow Fund remained committed to attracting, supporting, and celebrating the food scientists and innovators of the future through three strategic promise areas: Motivate, Support, and Leverage. One of our proudest accomplishments this past year fell under the Support promise, which allocates scholarships to students pursuing degrees in science of food disciplines. With diversity, equity, and inclusion top of mind, we reviewed our scholarship portfolio with an eye toward greater access for underrepresented groups. That review resulted in new opportunities and a more inclusive process that expands eligibility and reduces barriers in the application process. I am delighted to announce that we were able to award 59 academic scholarships, totaling \$117,800, to the broadest selection of students ever. Strategy is in place to further expand our reach and attract even more students from diverse backgrounds over the next few years.

Because travel was limited this past year due to ongoing pandemic restrictions, our Leverage promise focused on supporting unique programs with global impact. The Feeding Tomorrow Fund proudly sponsored the IFT Student Association competition—Developing Solutions for Developing Countries—and helped provide food science education to 65 undergraduate and graduate students in Nigeria with a grant of \$1,680.

The Feeding Tomorrow Fund also continued to advance partnerships with educators and influencers, such as the National Science Teachers Association, to ensure that young people are introduced to food science and technology as a potential career path. Through similar collaborations and partnerships, we provided teachers with information and curricula to inspire and educate youth as young as the elementary school grades.

In the next 30 years, the worldwide population is projected to reach nearly 10 billion—and we will need to find ways to provide them safe, nutritious, and plentiful food. This requires nurturing a pipeline of bright, innovative, and creative science of food talent ready to tackle this and many other global food system challenges. I hope I can count on your ongoing generous support as we champion this next generation. They will need everything we can give them.

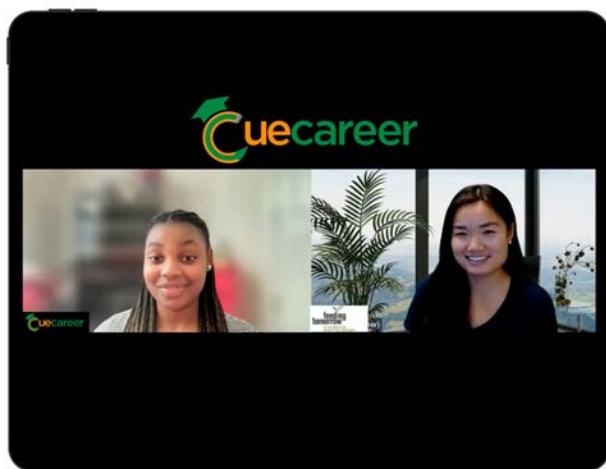

We Motivate

The world needs the next generation of creative and innovative minds engaged in the science of food to meet a critical challenge ahead of us: feeding a projected global population of nearly 10 billion by 2050. Yet, science of food educators report alarming declines in the number of students enrolled in food science studies. The Feeding Tomorrow Fund is dedicated to reversing this troubling trend by inspiring the next generation to consider careers in food science—and connecting with them early. We offer engaging educational content to elementary and middle-school teachers so that they can introduce food science careers to students in fun ways. Creative lessons such as “Abracadabra! Transforming Yogurt into Raviolis” and “How Greasy Are Your Potato Chips?” are available for free on IFT’s website.

IFT members participate in [Cue Career Videos](#) to inspire young people to consider careers in the science of food. The series features high school and college students who conduct interviews with young professionals in the field to learn about their day-to-day work, salaries, IFT involvement, and more.

In partnership with organizations like Cue Career, Pathful, the Chicagoland Food Science Foundation, and McCormick/Fona, we are mobilizing volunteers to share their passion about career pathways in the science of food.

We Support

Through the Feeding Tomorrow Fund, IFT actively addresses barriers to education in the sciences, particularly for those most impacted by food inequity. As the cost of college rises and education slips out of reach for many, Feeding Tomorrow Fund scholarships help ensure that those passionate about careers in the science of food can still pursue their dreams. Since 1985, the Feeding Tomorrow Fund has awarded more than 2,700 scholarships, totaling over \$3 million. During 2021-22, we presented 59 academic scholarship awards totaling \$117,800

This year we were pleased to introduce the **Gateway Scholarship Program**. Anchored in our commitment to inclusion, this new program expands educational access to promising students who are not enrolled in an IFT-approved undergraduate program.

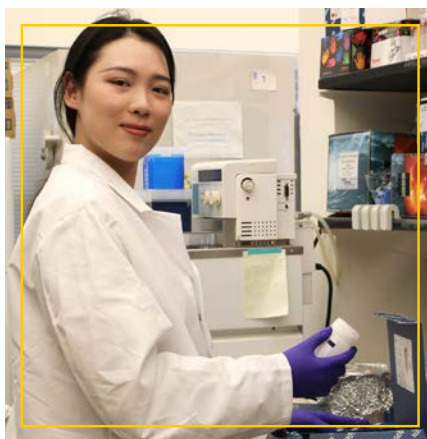

Meet the 2022 Caldwell Fellowship Recipient

Yutong Li was selected as the 2022 recipient of the Dr. Elwood Caldwell Graduate Fellowship, an award totaling \$25,800. Now in its second year, the fellowship is the result of a \$1 million bequest from the late longtime IFT member Elwood Caldwell, PhD, and supports students enrolled in a master's or doctoral program in the science of food whose research addresses the demands of the global food system.

Li is a doctoral candidate in food science at The Ohio State University with an emphasis in food microbiology. Previously, she earned a BS in food science and technology, also from Ohio State.

Jingsi Liu is a first-year doctoral student under the guidance of Yun Yin, PhD, in the food flavor lab at Virginia Tech and is studying the influences of environmental stress on plant metabolites and their aroma compounds. Celebrating the Return of Fun Run + Fitness

We were thrilled to welcome back our in-person Fun Run + Fitness in 2022 at the IFT FIRST: Annual Event and Expo, after a two-year pause (virtual only) due to the pandemic. Thanks to our generous participants and fitness sponsors we raised more than \$75,000 in scholarship funds to benefit the future of our profession: students pursuing education in science of food careers.

We Leverage

Developing Solutions for Developing Countries

The IFT Student Association (IFTSA) engages student members from around the world to leverage their scientific skills toward a greater cause. Through a \$6,500 sponsorship from the Feeding Tomorrow Fund, IFTSA's Developing Solutions for Developing Countries (DSDC) product development competition promotes the application of food science and technology and the creation of new products and processes to improve the quality of life for those in developing countries.

DadYo

MahasiswaPL (Marcellus Arnold and Yolanda Victoria Rajagukguk)

DadYo is a shelf-stable, synbiotic yogurt with live probiotics made by using indigenous “dadih” starter culture. Dadih is an almost-extinct traditional yogurt made from buffalo milk with origins in West Sumatera, Indonesia. The MahasiswaPL team interviewed individuals from their local food science community and proposed a product development concept that matched this year's DSDC topic: to create a shelf-stable yogurt beverage that contains live and active cultures without a kill step in production. The result is DadYo, a product that benefits the health and economy of the local population while raising awareness about the extinction of culinary heritage.



We Leverage

Feeding Tomorrow Fund Grant: Providing Food Science Education in Nigeria

Through a \$1,680 grant from the Feeding Tomorrow Fund, the Nigerian Institute of Food Science and Technology (NIFST), partnered with the IFT International Division's Food Science for Relief and Development (FSRD) project to provide food science education to 65 undergraduate and graduate students. A nonprofit representing food professionals from academia, industry, government, and research agencies, NIFST offered an educational session aimed at transforming collective knowledge into innovative solutions while also strengthening relationships among food professionals and building greater capacity.

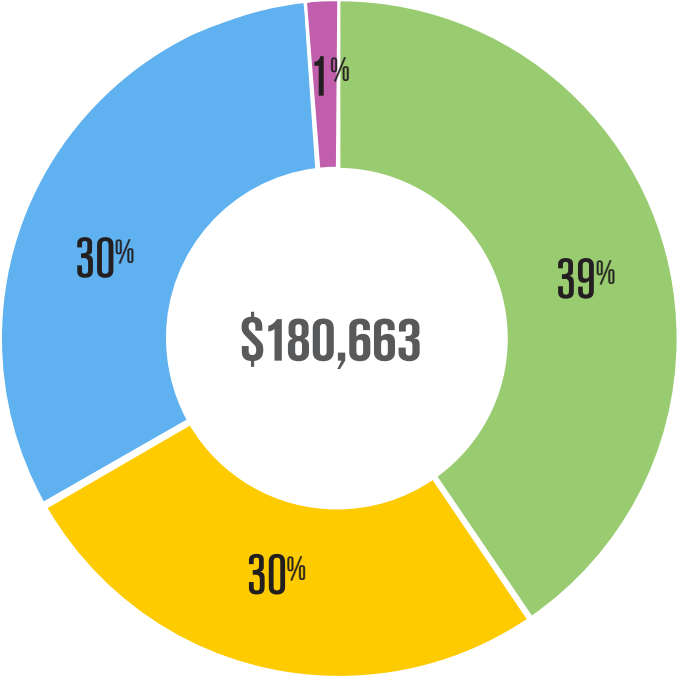

Financials as of August 31, 2022

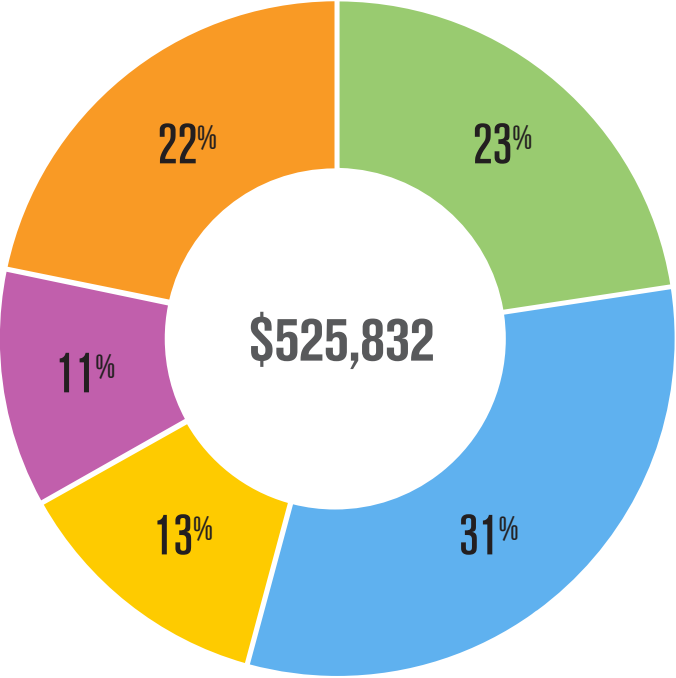
